Faculty of Economics and Business Student Exchange Travel Scholarships

Conditions of Award 2010

The scholarships shall be awarded under the following conditions:

1. The scholarships are available to local and international, undergraduate and postgraduate students currently enrolled in a coursework program and under the administration of the Faculty of Economics and Business.
2. To be eligible for the scholarship, students must be successfully selected by the University of Sydney for student exchange for at least one semester duration at any of the partner institutions available through the University of Sydney Exchange program, where studies at the exchange institution may be credited to an Economics and Business degree.
3. The scholarships will be awarded automatically and ranked on the basis of academic merit (determined by Weighted Average Mark) for all University of Sydney units of study completed in the student's enrolled Economics and Business degree at the time of selection. No application is necessary. Selection will be made prior to the usual departure period and after a confirmed final list is issued from the Exchange Unit, International Office and received at the Faculty.
4. The scholarships are valued at \$2,000 each and tenable for one semester on exchange. Students participating on exchange for two semesters will automatically be considered again for the following semester. Notification of a scholarship offer will be in writing and payment will be made after the recipient's exchange places have been confirmed.
5. There are up to 20 scholarships offered each year. The number of scholarships offered each semester may be commensurate with participation numbers from the previous year and an indication of the exchange application/numbers taken at the Exchange Office for the semester of the award.
6. The scholarship is offered for, and is tenable in, a specific degree program and is not transferable to another degree program.
8. Scholarship recipients must enrol full-time and meet the conditions of their degree program and exchange arrangements during the tenure of the scholarship or are liable to repay the scholarship funding.
9. Requests to suspend the scholarship after a confirmed offer will only be approved under exceptional circumstances such as a severe medical condition which limits the student's capacity to undertake the exchange. Such requests must be supported by the Dean of the Faculty.
10. Recipients already in receipt of a Faculty of Economics and Business Scholarship funding for their exchange may not hold a second exchange scholarship from the Faculty but may be eligible to hold this award with other University awards for exchange (pending the terms and conditions of the other award).
