Faculty of Economics and Business, the Women's College, St. Andrew's College and Wesley College Foundation INDIGENOUS AUSTRALIAN SCHOLARSHIP

In 2010 the Faculty of Economics and Business at the University of Sydney will offer an Indigenous Australian Scholarship in partnership with the Wesley College Foundation (WCF), the Women's College and St Andrew's College to support a student studying in the Faculty and residing at Wesley College, St. Andrew's College or the Women's College.

1. The scholarship is to be awarded in 2010 for up to 4 years, to an Australian Indigenous student:
 - who will be enrolled in the Faculty of Economics and Business at the University of Sydney and
 - who will be resident at Wesley College, the Women's College and St Andrew's College and
 - who, but for the scholarship, would be unable to attend Wesley College, the Women's College or St Andrew's College
 - who, has financial disadvantage and demonstrates a potential to succeed in an area of study taught within the Faculty.
2. The scholarship will be for full payment of College Fees which includes accommodation and meals. Alternatively, for those students who have their fees paid by another grant or scholarship (e.g. ABSTUDY) the scholarship can be taken as a \$6,000 grant from the Faculty of Economics and Business towards living expenses (if taken as a grant, a payment of \$3,000 will be made at the start of each semester).

NB. Students with alternative accommodation arrangements (that is, not residing at one of the partner residential colleges) are also eligible to apply and will be considered for a Faculty of Economics and Business \$6,000 p.a. grant, in the event that a scholarship could not be awarded to applicants from the participating Residential Colleges.

3. Under normal conditions, there are up to two scholarship recipients each year. To continue to receive the Scholarship, the recipient must be enrolled full-time and maintain satisfactory academic progress.
4. The scholarship will be awarded by the Faculty of Economics and Business and by the respective Hall of Residence of Wesley College Foundation, the Women's College, St Andrew's College in consultation with the Koori Centre at Sydney University.
5. **CONFIRMATION OF INDIGENOUS DESCENT** - please attach your confirmation to this application. As this scholarship is specifically for Indigenous Australians, applicants are also required to provide confirmation that they are of Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent. This confirmation can be in the form of a letter of identity from your local Land Council, Legal Service, Medical Service, or other official Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander organisation, or a Statutory Declaration. The Koori centre also has applicants complete a 'Proof of identity' check (to establish Indigenous descent).

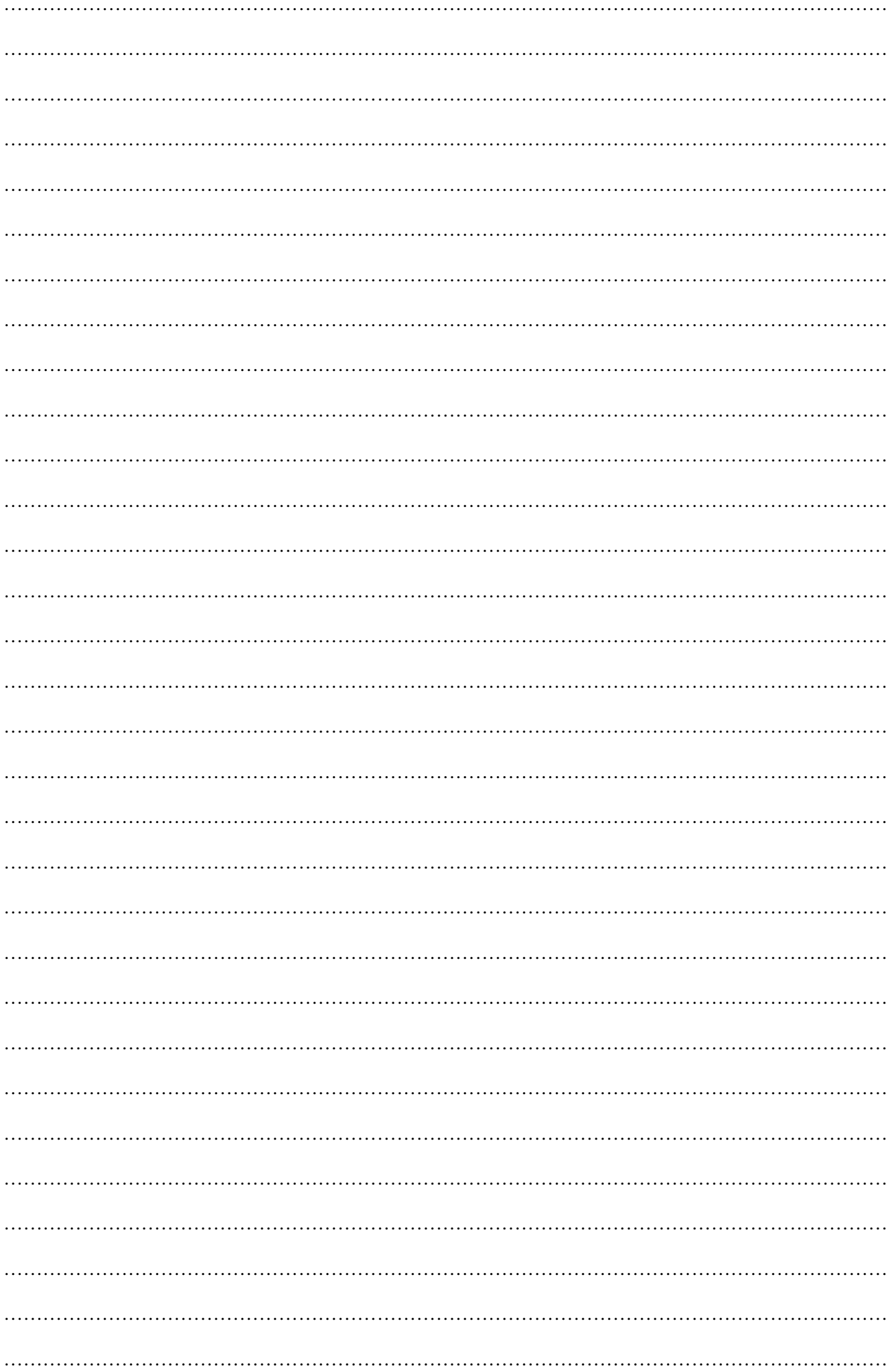
