The Gilles Kryger Honours Scholarship in Finance Conditions of Award

The scholarship first established in 2006 by a donation from alumnus, Mr. Gilles Kryger and the Faculty of Economics and Business. The scholarship is titled 'The Gilles Kryger Honors Scholarship in Finance'.

The scholarship is intended to promote academic excellence at the undergraduate Finance Honours level.

The scholarship is valued at \$15,000 and tenable for one year. An amount of \$7,500 will be paid at the commencement of the recipient's honours year and the final installment of \$7,500 will be paid on submission of their honours thesis in early November.

The scholarship is open to local and international undergraduate students who successfully gain entry to Finance Honours and will be completing their honours year in full-time study with the Faculty of Economics and Business.

The Faculty of Economics and Business will short-list a small group of students based on academic merit demonstrated in the Finance specialization.

Those students short-listed will be invited to apply. The application will require completion (by a stated date) of a research assignment prepared by the Discipline of Finance. The assignment will allow the student to demonstrate his/her understanding of finance theory and capacity for original thought and research related to finance. Final selection will be made by staff within the Discipline of Finance at the discretion of the Chair of Discipline.

The scholarship may not be awarded to a student who is in receipt of other funding specifically awarded for the student's honours year or in receipt of a scholarship of equal or higher value

The scholarship holder is liable to return the funding in full if they withdraw from their honours year.
