



Faculty of Economics and Business Strategic Exchange Partner Scholarship

Conditions of Award 2010

The scholarship shall be awarded under the following conditions:

1. The scholarships are available to local and international, undergraduate and postgraduate students currently enrolled in a coursework program under the administration of the Faculty of Economics and Business.
2. To be eligible for the scholarship, students must be successfully selected by the University of Sydney for at least one semester student exchange at one of the Faculty's strategic partners. Studies undertaken at the exchange institution must be eligible for credit back to the student's currently enrolled Economics and Business degree.
3. The scholarships are valued at \$3,000 each and tenable for one semester of exchange. Students participating on exchange for two semesters will be automatically considered again for the following semester. Notification of a scholarship offer will be in writing and payment will be made after the recipient's exchange place has been confirmed.
4. If the scholarship money is not fully allocated, the remainder will be provided to the second round of students who have applied for one of the strategic faculty partners.
5. In the event that more than one student applies for a particular strategic partner, only one student will be awarded based on best academic performance. The student will be awarded based on Weighted Average Mark for all University of Sydney units of study completed in the student's enrolled Economics and Business degree at the time of selection. If the number of students then eligible for award based on academic performance outweighs scholarship places for that semester then each top ranked student from each strategic partner institution will move through a second round of selection based on Weighted Average Mark again. No application is necessary. Selection will be made prior to the usual departure period and after a confirmed final list is issued from the Exchange Unit, International Office and received at the Faculty.
6. Up to 20 strategic scholarships are offered each year. The number of scholarships offered each semester may be commensurate with participation numbers from the previous year and an indication of the exchange application/numbers taken at the Exchange Office for the semester of the award.
7. A list of Strategic Partner Institutions will be available 12 months in advance of the exchange session for award. The list will be available on the Faculty exchange website:

8. The scholarship is offered for, and is tenable in, a specific degree program and is not transferable to another degree program.
9. Scholarship recipients must enrol full-time and meet the conditions of their degree program and exchange arrangements during the tenure of the scholarship or are liable to repay the scholarship funding.
10. Requests to suspend the scholarship offer will only be approved under exceptional circumstances such as a severe medical condition which limits the student's capacity to undertake the exchange. Such requests must be supported by the Dean of the Faculty.
11. Recipients of this scholarship are not eligible to hold any Faculty Scholarships for the purpose of exchange. Recipients of this scholarship may be eligible for other University awards for the purpose of exchange, pending the terms and conditions of that award.
