Littrell-Cartwright International Exchange Scholarship Conditions of Award

Originally established in 2006 by annual donation from Mr. Charles Littrell and Dr. Kimberly Cartwright. The scholarship is titled the '**Littrell-Cartwright International Exchange Scholarship**'.

The scholarship is valued at \$8,000 as a one-off payment, tenable during the recipient's exchange program.

Two awards may be given in The University of Sydney's Spring Session in 2009 and one award in Autumn session 2010.

The scholarship is open to undergraduate and postgraduate, international and local students under the administration of Economics and Business, who are participating in The University of Sydney Exchange program and are (applying/have been accepted) to a partner institution in the program.

Applicants are asked to submit an Expression of Interest form and then are short-listed based on academic merit (determined by Weighted Average Mark) in their currently enrolled coursework degree. The short-listed group will then be asked to submit a personal statement for final selection detailing areas such as financial need and an aptitude to excel personally and academically whilst participating on exchange, following this some applicants may be asked to attend an interview.

The application process for spring session commences in late March and final selection will be made in early June.

The successful applicant must be accepted to a partner institution and will undertake the exchange program to receive the scholarship.

The scholarship holder is liable to return the funding in full if they withdraw from The University of Sydney Exchange Program.

The scholarship may not be awarded to a student who is in receipt of other funding specifically awarded to assist with the student's exchange program.

The scholarship may not be deferred except with the permission of the Dean.
